JCP Process Revised

March 9: JCP officials announced that the Java Community Process, the official procedure for defining Java programming standards, is being updated to enable earlier participation by developers.

Currently, each Java Specification Requests (JSR) undergoes early and later review periods. Under the current process, the first review is available only to official JCP members while the second review is available to the public.

Under the soon-to-be-released JCP 2.6, the public may provide comment and feedback on the first review. Additionally, there will be opportunities for developers to participate in a JSR without committing the time to be part of a JSR expert group. For more information: jcp.org
